This is where you guys come in. Do you have verifiable cases in which lecturers or professors have attracted

attention with right-wing attitudes? Have students complained because they heard something? Or have there been speeches by university staff on right-wing issues? If particularly sensitive information is involved: Protection of sources is important to us. No one necessarily has to appear with their own name, there is always a way to anonymize the whole thing. A whistleblower is enough for us, the further research is then our task. So please feel free to write us anything you can think of. You can also call us, you can find my contact details in the signature. We are looking forward to the cooperation.
